News from the Gold Coast Board. (a little more detailed)

Based on feedback from members in our Gold Coast Emmaus Community and the many discussions had, the Board has made the following decisions:

Both Walks scheduled for May 2021 have been moved to October 2021.

The following dates are in place:

Walk #144 Thursday Oct. 21st through to Sunday 24th &

Walk #145 Thursday Oct. 28th through to Sunday 31st.

Deposits paid for our May Walks have been moved to October, no cost for this move was incurred.

Both Walks will be held at the new venue on Mount Tamborine — Mount Tamborine Conference Centre.

Our first Gathering for 2021 will be held on the First Saturday of every month. Our initial plan is to go with this new arrangement for the remainder of day light saving. As Easter Saturday is the first Saturday in April and daylight saving ends on Easter Sunday, our Gathering planned for April will fall on the 2nd Saturday, being the 10th.

Our first Board meeting for 2021 will be held at the Burleigh CoC on Saturday February 6th. Holding our Board meeting on the same day as our Gathering removes the need to book the Burleigh CoC on another day of the month and it will also remove the night driving.

HI, my name is Mieke Bell, and I attended a Emmaus walk in Ballina, in 1990, and what a life changing experience that was, as I am sure you will all agree!!

Sometime later I joined the Chrysalis Committee and had the joy of seeing young people's lives impacted by the love of Jesus. Then fast forward a few more years and became involved in the Kairos Ministry, both Kairos Inside for Men, in the Grafton jail, and then Kairos Outside for Women, a ministry that supports women who have had family members in jail.

Kairos Inside for Men ran the last Short Course for Men in the old Grafton jail in September 2019, and now the new Clarence Correctional Centre in Grafton is asking the Committee to run Short Courses for both men and women in the new jail. God is opening the doors very wide, and as a Kairos Committee in Grafton, we are very excited!! What a great opportunity to share Gods Love, Grace and Forgiveness with the inmates, many of whom have never been told that GOD LOVES them.

I believe that God uses our experience and training at Emmaus to prepare us for ministries such as Kairos. Kairos Inside for Men and Women is Life Transforming, paving the way for the transforming Love of Jesus to impact the lives of the men and women in green.

Our first short Course for Women is planned for June this year (2021).

Virtual Emmaus Test Session

Saturday 7th January 2021 the first test session for a virtual Emmaus Walk was held via Zoom, I along with Olga Kucsak, were participants in the session, along with 23 others from Communities all over Australia, and from Nashville, Texas, and North Carolina just to name a few places.

A little of the background, this option for Emmaus has been in development for the past 3 to 4 months. This session was the first of two being held over the course of the weekend, the second session was held at approx. 3am AEDT Sunday morning, and would involve Communities again from the USA, Europe and Africa.

The session began at 9am Daylight Savings time and lasted about 3 hours, it consisted of two elements, the first being a talk, which for this session was Life of Piety, followed by a reflection by the Spiritual Director for the event. For the first part of the session, the speaker for the talk, lit a candle which was visible throughout her talk. In the discussion we had post this session, it was suggested that perhaps a separate window, which would allow it to be shown throughout the sessions when this form becomes live.

At the completion of the talk, we were broken off into break out rooms, each of these rooms were allocated a table name, as per the Walks, ours was the Table of Mark. There was as we do, the discussion and reflection and review. There is no posters nor would, there be a poster party at the end of each day. When we were brought back to the main screen, we had an comments were favourable.

An inquiry as to how it was proposed this type of Walk would proceed, we were told it is envisioned that the Walk would be held on a Friday night/Saturday morning over a 4 week period. It was also revealed that the Pilgrims would be given something, they did not want to call it homework, to keep them engaged between sessions. The question of agape was also raised, with the response being that agape would still be an important part of the experience, as to how this would work, was still being looked into, however it was felt the sponsors would be involved in delivering this. Sponsorship would remain the same as it is for the current Walks. The only difference would be the Pilgrims would have a pre Walk session to ensure they were up to date and capable of using Zoom.

As to materials the Pilgrims are normally given on the Walks, these would either be given electronically, which means the Pilgrims would have to download and print the material if they wanted hard copies, the alternative, again would involve the Sponsor, who would deliver the hard copy of the Worship book and other material to the Pilgrim.

The second part of the session, was the Friday morning communion, This was presented as a no element communion, this was then followed by another prayer that divided the participants as to the relevance of it and some felt the lack of elements detracted from the act of communion. The service followed the Worship book from page 26 to the top of Page 29. The act of receiving was the following prayer shared by all:

Blessed Jesus though we cannot meet around your table, and receive You in bread and juice, we believe that You are with us here and now in this place. Come into our hearts and enlighten our inner darkness as, by Your grace, we unite to You. Open our eyes to Your wonderful presence in creation, in the redemption of Your children, and in Your sustaining of the world. Remind each one of us gathered here today that we are united as members of Your body. Help us grow together in richer and fuller communion. And, as we offer ourselves to You, may we share in Your risen life which renews the whole of creation.

Amen

This was followed by the Lord's Prayer then the following short prayer

Lord Jesus be with each participant in this event. Dwell in us. Be our wisdom. Be our guide. Conform us in word and in action to your image, You who with the Father and the Holy Spirit live and reign for evermore.

Amen.

This was then followed by the Body Prayer. (this is the prayer that divided opinion).

Overall this was an interesting experience that does have potential, for not only the Walk to Emmaus, also other areas within our communities. It will be interesting to see how this develops and what the future holds.

I would be willing to discuss anything from this session with anyone of you who may like to know more.


