Saturday Gatherings.

During 2019 - 2020 the Board discussed how our community has grown. Some of our growth came through the enthusiasm and focus of Gold Coast community and some came through the involvement of people who attended FNC Emmaus and live on the Far North Coast of NSW. Day light saving for the 6 months of each year meant that FNC residents would travel at night. It was suggested we try a Saturday Gathering instead of the Friday night.

At our March Gathering, the Board will invite everyone to indicate their preference to cease or continue with Saturday Gatherings. Your prayers for the best outcome would be appreciated.

Here are 5 Ways to Develop Healthy Habits:

- Remember whose you are. You are called by God and made in His image. Because of His great love for you, you have the ability to become more like the person God created you to be.
- Identify the "why" behind your behavior.[†] Do you eat junk food because you like the taste? Or because you're tired or bored? Once you know *why* you behave the way you do, it's easier to replace unhealthy habits with better ones.
- Draw close to God. When you prioritize time with God, you're allowing Him to renew your mind (Rom. 12:2). Eventually, this will help you change the way you live.
- Focus on one key habit. Consistently doing one thing well will yield results over time and make it easier to master other habits later.
- **Give yourself grace.** You won't always get it right... And that's okay. When you stumble, "fall forward": learn from your mistakes and keep going. God will still be right beside you, cheering you on.

It only takes a moment to start a healthy habit. Plan a change, and let God use that choice to begin transforming your daily routines.
